

D. <u>Divisional Results</u>

The divisional tournament directors are responsible for e-mailing the results of their divisional tournament to Scott Roberts (scott.roberts@ncbb.net) no later than Sunday, February 20, by 8:00 a.m. <u>Please include first and last name, grade, and school of wrestlers</u>. If any known changes occur after the deadline, please contact Tournament Director Jeff Winger ASAP at (916) 747-8533 or Steve Cole at (916) 765-4485.

E. Entry Fees

The entry fee for the 2011 Masters Tournament is \$20.00 per wrestler. Each school will be required to pay for all Masters Meet qualifying athletes, regardless of whether they actually wrestle or not. There will be no alternates competing in this tournament. Only checks or money orders will be accepted. Please make checks payable to CIF Sac-Joaquin Section. Coaches will not receive their registration packets until they have paid the entry fees.

F. Registration

Coaches must pick up and pay for their packets before their wrestlers can enter Stockton Arena. Coaches may register Thursday, February 24 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Grand Hotel, 2323 Grand Canal Blvd., Stockton. *NOTE: It is highly recommended that coaches register on Thursday evening to avoid any issues that may occur on Friday morning.* Coaches, however, may also register Friday morning at Stockton Arena from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.

For registration and entrance of competitors, coaches, statkeepers and those on the pass list, enter Stockton Arena through the north (main) entrance.

Each competitor will receive a pass (and lanyard) with the word ATHLETE printed on it that will be good for both days. Competitors must possess this pass and have a photo identification to enter Stockton Arena.

G. Weigh-Ins and Groom Check

Scales will be made available to check weights beginning at 6:00 a.m. on both Friday and Saturday. Absolutely NO dehydration activities will be allowed in the weigh-in area (the main floor of the arena). All wrestlers must be in the weigh-in area by 7:00 a.m. The weigh-ins will begin at 7:00 a.m. sharp and continue until the last weight class has weighed in. Groom check will be performed before a wrestle weighs in. For more detailed information regarding weigh-ins, see Page 6 of this format.

H. Competition Weigh-in Form

Each coach is required to bring his/her team's Competition Weigh-in Form to the Sac-Joaquin Section Masters competition. Tournament officials will retain all forms.

PENALTY: Failure to comply will result in the entire team being ineligible to compete and charged with forfeiture.

I. Weight Classes

The following weight classes will be in effect for the CIF Sac-Joaquin Section/Les Schwab Tires Masters Meet Presented by Farmers Insurance.

Note: The 2-pound growth allowance will be used in accordance with the National Federation Wrestling rules (Rule 4-4-4). In addition, there will be a 1-pound allowance for Saturday morning weigh-ins (Rule 4-5-5).

J. <u>Entries Per Weight Class</u>

The number of entries per weight class is 32. Each divisional will qualify the following in each weight class:

Division I North	8
Division I South	5
Division II	6
Division III	4
Division IV	5
Division V	4

Note: Those wrestlers who qualify from the divisional tournaments and fail to show or fail to make weight will forfeit. No alternates or substitutes will be allowed.

K. Rules

The National Federation 2010-11 Wrestling Rules Book will be the official rules for the tournament, superseded by the Sac-Joaquin Section and State CIF rules.

L. Wrestler Eligibility

Only wrestlers who are eligible according to CIF, league and local school rules will be eligible for the tournament.

M. <u>Team Scoring</u>

Scoring will follow National Federation 2010-11 Wrestling Rules Book regulations (Rule 9-2-3).

N. Coaches' Matside Seating

A maximum of two certified team coaches will be permitted in the restricted mat area. Chairs will be provided and coaches are to remain in those chairs. Only one coach may approach the scoring table. Only those coaches with proper wristbands will be permitted at matside.

0. Coaches' Passes

Coaches from participating schools will receive a quantity of wristbands based upon the number of wrestlers representing their schools.

1-2 wrestlers = 2 coaches' wristbands

3-9 wrestlers = 3 coaches' wristbands

10+ wrestlers = 4 coaches' wristbands

Please do not ask for extra coaches' wristbands. Lost wristbands will not be replaced. Only those coaches with properly displayed wristbands will be permitted at matside. As a common courtesy, head coaches are ultimately responsible to purchase extra tickets at the gate for non-participating teammates, statkeepers or other team supporters.

P. <u>Statkeepers</u>

Each school will be allowed up to 2 statkeepers for free admission. Statkeepers must enter at the North (main) entrance and be accompanied by a coach to receive a wristband, which will be good for admission on both days.

Q. Admission Prices

Adults — \$15.00

Students — \$8.00

Note: Food, beverages and ice chests will NOT be allowed into Stockton Arena. All backpacks will be searched by Stockton Arena personnel.

R. Passes

- 1. No league, district, school, NCOA or Section green passes will be honored.
- 2. Only Section orange PLAYOFF passes, Section light blue PRESS passes, State courtesy cards and State or Section Gold Lifetime passes will be honored.
- 3. The pass gate will be located at the west security entrance.

S. Parking

- 1. Cars are asked to park in the surface lots.
- 2. RVs are asked to park in the west parking lot.

T. Warm-up Area

There will be a warm up area available. When wrestlers are sent to a mat, they will be expected to be ready to wrestle!

U. <u>Uniforms</u>

All athletes competing in the championships must wear their high school uniform. Uniforms of all team members must be identical. Unless specifically approved by tournament management, the wearing of sweatsuits, T-shirts or any clothing representing any organization, corporation or business, college or university is strictly prohibited and may result in disqualification.

V. <u>Bracket Information</u>

Bracket information will be available online at www.cifsjs.org on Monday, February 21, 2011.

W. Weight-Class Pairings

Pairings for the weight classes will be done by the Sac-Joaquin Section office and the tournament directors.

X. Spectators

The CIF Sac-Joaquin Section Championships are conducted under the strictest code of good sportsmanship. Rooters are encouraged to support their own school's representative, and are expected to refrain from booing the opponents or the officials' decisions. Banners will not be permitted inside the arena.

Y. Awards

Coaches are to instruct their athletes to cooperate with the officials by reporting to the victory stand immediately following the last match. In order to receive an award, contestants must report to the victory stand wearing their school's official uniform. No unofficial hats or sandals will be allowed. Wrestling or tennis shoes required. Athletes must be on the awards stand to receive their award.

Team Awards: A championship pennant will be awarded to the 1st place team. All qualifiers to the State Championships will receive a large medal.

Z. State Championships

The top seven place winners in each weight class (no alternates) will qualify to the State Championships held at Rabobank Arena in Bakersfield March 4 and 5, 2011.

Sac-Joaquin Masters Meet Weigh-ins 2011

(Note: Please read the weigh-in procedures listed below very carefully and make sure that your wrestlers understand the procedures and timelines.)

WEIGH-IN AREAS AND PROCEDURE:

- The weigh-in area and check scales will be open at 6:00 a.m.
- The weigh-in area will be on the main floor of the arena.
- All wrestlers must be in the weigh-in area by 7:00 a.m.
- Each weight class will have an assigned area on the main floor.
- Coaches are not allowed on the main floor.
- The only individuals allowed on the main floor are the wrestlers and the tournament staff.
- The Weigh Master will conduct the weigh-in and check conformance to appearance as required by the National Federation 2010-11 Wrestling Rules Book.
- The announcer will begin to make calls at 6:45 for all wrestlers to go to the mats. He will make calls every 5 minutes and make a final call to the mats at 6:59.
- If multiple scales are available, a contestant may step on and off the first scale two times to allow for mechanical inconsistencies in that scale. If the contestant fails to make weight on the first scale, the contestant shall immediately step on each available scale one time in an attempt to make weight. During time off the scale (s), activities that promote dehydration are prohibited. (NFHS Rule 4-5-3)
- The weigh-ins will begin at 7:00 a.m. sharp and continue until the last weight class has weighed in.








CIF SAC-JOAQUIN SECTION PLAYOFFS ACCEPTABLE PASS SHEET 2010-11


PLAYOFF PASS (ORANGE)




PRESS PASS (LIGHT BLUE)
